### Instructors

As a member and soloist with the Polish National Dance Company, Mazowsze, Dorota toured and performed throughout Europe, Israel, Canada and the United States.

Dorota has taught and choreographed for the Vermillion and Lewis and Clark Playhouses, various Nutcracker Ballets, Sioux City Symphony, the University of South Dakota, and the School of Ballet Omaha.

**Mandi Ewald** began dancing with the Academy of Dance at the age of three and was trained in all styles of dance. Mandi was on the YHS Dance Team throughout high school and is the captain of U.Dance at the University of South Dakota in Vermillion. She has coordinated high school summer dance camps and choreographed for various high school teams. Mandi is a junior pursuing a major in Public Relations and Advertising.

## Classes and Dress Codes

**Pre-ballet:** Students will improve strength and coordination through tumbling exercises and dance movements.

*(Girls: Theatrical pink tights, black leotard and pink leather ballet shoes.*

*Boys: T-shirts, shorts and black jazz shoes.)*

**Dance Team and Hip Hop:** These classes offer the style of athletic jazz that everyone enjoys seeing at athletic events.

*(Leotard with shorts or jazz pants, tights or socks, black jazz shoes.)*

### **Registration**

A deposit of \$30.00 is required for each class. The deposit will apply to the spring performance costume fee. If we are notified by Dec. 1, 2010 that the costume is not needed, the entire deposit will apply to tuition.

## Dance Class Policies

1. No gum or candy in the dance area.
2. Students are to arrive no more than 15 minutes prior to class and be picked up immediately after class.
3. Hair must be pulled back out of eyes. No dangling necklaces or earrings.
4. Children must wait inside for their ride.
5. We hold a Visiting Day for family and friends to observe class. Please do not sit in the dance area.
6. Parents need to take 3-5 year olds to the restroom before class begins.
7. Attendance will be taken in each class.
8. Students who miss 50% of classes will not be eligible to perform in the spring performances.
9. Final dance class placement is at the discretion of the Academy of Dance.
10. In case of bad weather, classes will be canceled whenever Public Schools are canceled. When this occurs, makeup classes will be scheduled.
11. Students who register for a session must pay for the entire semester. No discounts for early withdrawals or missed classes.
12. Each family will be given one free ticket for the spring performances. Admission is charged for extra tickets to cover production expenses.
13. The Academy of Dance and its employees shall not be liable for any accidents.
